

# Warwick National Novice Sabre Tournament

(Last updated: 10.02.2022, 20:06)

**Tickets available for Men's competition: 34/49**

**Tickets available for Women's competition: 30/35**

## Entry requirements

If you have **had up to 2 full years of training in any weapon (not including training this academic year)** you are eligible to compete. Note that **partial training due to Covid counts towards this** (though only up to the amount of training that took place). For example, a fencer who has had one full year of training before Covid and half a regular year's worth during Covid would be allowed to compete; but someone who has had two uninterrupted years of training plus a partial training during Covid would not be allowed. Please use your discretion and remember that this is a competition aimed at novices, and the standard of any fencers attending should be such.

## What you need to know

- It is taking place: **13th of February 08.00 - 18.00 at Sports and Wellness Hub (Zone D), University of Warwick, Coventry, CV4 7EU.**
- Competition will be in **sabre**.
- Women and Men will compete in different groups.
- Entry costs **£18**, you will have to purchase a ticket (non-member) online (make sure you do so before they get sold out to avoid disappointment!)

- **If we find out that someone who is not eligible has entered the competition, they will be disqualified, and the ticket will NOT be refunded.**
- With the current guidance it is required that you **wear a mask** whilst not fencing.

## Before the competition

1. **Men's competition check-in starts at 9:00 closes at 9:30.**
2. **Check-in for the Women's competition starts at 10:30 closes at 11:15.**
3. Please make sure you have **water** with you (there will be a possibility to refill your bottle) and **something to eat** as it will be a long day! There is Caffe Nero at the facility as well as shops that you can walk/drive to on and nearby the campus.
4. There is **parking available on site opposite the sports centre** (£1 per day).
5. Make sure that you have appropriate **fencing equipment**:
  1. **Mask**: it must be a sabre mask. Make sure it has a **back strap**, so it is safe to fence in. Referees have the right to not let you fence if they think the mask does not meet the safety requirements.
  2. **Lame**: please make sure it has no dead spots and that all fencers have their own lame and do not have to share it with someone else.
  3. **Sabre (size 5)**: again, please make sure all fencers have their own lame and do not have to share it with someone else.
  4. **Glove**: make sure that this is a sabre glove, it must be a **800N**.
  5. **Wires**: you need both a **headwire** and a **bodywire**.
  6. **Breeches**: you will not be allowed to fence unless you have breeches on.
  7. **Jacket**
  8. **Plastron**: it must be a **800N**.

9. **Chest protector:** mandatory for women.
  10. **Long socks:** these must be until your knees.
  11. **Shoes**
6. If you can, please bring a **box & spools** with you just in case some of ours break.
  7. We would really appreciate if all clubs could have **at least one referee** with them, however it is okay, if you don't have one.
  8. Finally, we would like to **invite you to our local pub, Varsity**, afterwards to have some drinks and a chat with each other!
